



THE VINEYARDS:

This wine is a combination of three vineyards located on the plains and gently rolling hills off Olivet and Guerneville roads in western Santa Rosa, this area provides an excellent medium for the coastal fog that blankets our fruit in the mornings and evenings. The cooling moisture facilitates a longer growing season in which Pinot Noir thrives.

THE GROWING SEASON:

Coming off one of the coolest and wettest winters in recent memory, bud break arrived about two weeks later than normal. Beyond this slow start to the growing season, we saw multiple heat spikes throughout the summer that brought the maturation of the vines more in line with seasons past.

THE WINEMAKING:

These grapes were harvested from our Stegman, Simeone, and Los Amigos vineyards in the Russian River Valley. Each lot was specifically selected for our rose program and pressed off their skins upon arrival to the winery.

THE WINE:

Our 2019 Rose Pinot of Noir displays faint colors of coral and salmon. It has a vivid ripe cherry-vanilla aroma, balanced by flavors of bright strawberry, rhubarb and cream.
