



THE VINEYARDS:

Chalk Hill is an appellation with, generally, warmer days than in the rest of the Russian River Valley, with a variety of volcanic and alluvial soils across the western foothills of the Mayacamas range, rising 200 to 300 feet in elevation. Here, at our Los Amigos Ranch, just South of Healdsburg, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot develop deep, bold flavors.

THE GROWING SEASON:

After a mild start to the growing season and bud break as expected, multiple heat spikes throughout the summer that brought the maturation of the vines more in line with seasons past.

THE WINEMAKING:

Our single vineyard Cabernet is aged for up to 20 months in a combination of European and American oak. For this 3rd Alarm Reserve offering, we've selected only 10 of the finest barrels to represent our premium Chalk Hill Cabernet Sauvignon.

THE WINE:

This Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, lovely aromas of ripe strawberry-vanilla with lively cherry and dried herbs. Well-structured with flowing flavors of dark cocoa and black cherry, finishing with an elegant combination of dried tobacco, peppercorn and currant.
